

# Child Care Center Allergy Information

Complete one form for each child with allergies. Please note: Pursuant to MN Statute 245A.41, subd. 1, before admitting a child for care, the license holder must obtain information about any known allergy from the child's parent, legal guardian or source of medical care and maintain current information about the allergy in the child's record. The child's allergy information must be available at all time including on-site, when on field trips, during transportation and in the area where food is prepared and served.
