



Maple Tree Childcare Center Supply List

Welcome to Maple Tree! We look forward to a long and happy association with your family. Thank you for providing the items on this list by your child's first day. Remember to label everything. Let me know if you have any questions. Thank you, Jennie

All children

- 2 current photos of your family (one for our picture wall and one for your child's file)
- Health care summary (to be completed by health care provider)
- Immunization form (if your child is under 15 months, your health care provider must sign this form; parents may sign the form for children who are older than 15 months)
- Permission slip
- Emergency card
- Developmental history
- Box of Kleenex *
- Change of clothes (these items will be stored at MT in one of our plastic shoe boxes)

Infants

- Disposable diapers
- Thick wipes in a box (refills can be sent after we set up that initial box)
- Diaper ointment
- 2 "Over the head" bibs (terry cloth type with circular cut-out for head or if you cannot find this type, you may send in two small snap bibs) *
- 2 Nuks (if applicable)
- 1 Sippy cup *
- Sleep sack, if you want your child covered at naptime
- Prepared formula/breast milk in plastic bottles labeled with child's first and last name (send in fresh supply for each day)
- Cereal/baby food for the day (store in our refrigerator)
- Note: once babies are on table foods, lunch must contain protein item, fruit, vegetable, and grain item

Toddlers

- 2 "Over the head" bibs (terry cloth type with circular cut-out for head) *
- Small nap blanket and pillow that can be kept at school throughout the week
- Lunch in a lunch box packed with a "blue ice" pack to keep it cool (remember to include: protein item, fruit, vegetable, and grain item); and a sippy cup for milk
- If applicable: Disposable diapers, thick wipes, diaper ointment

Preschoolers

- Small nap blanket/pillow that can be kept at school throughout the week
- Lunch in a lunch box packed with a "blue ice" pack to keep it cool (remember to include: protein item, fruit, vegetable, and grain item)
- Note: if your child is not trained you will need to send in disposable diapers and thick wipes (untrained preschoolers follow the toddler tuition schedule)
